The Michigan Bar announced some ideas they have for improving the state's judicial system. The bar formed the judicial crossroads taskforce which came up with recommendations. The taskforce says the state can't afford the current system, so the ideas they've come up with cut back on costs in some way.

The taskforce came up with three elements they say will save money, but also preserve services. The first recommendation- streamline the court system, which includes reorganizing the entire structure on a court-to-court basis. The second- use technology more efficiently. They want to mandate and implement uniform technology standards and upgrade the current systems. Its final recommendation- fix the justice system's "fundamental problems" by coming up with ways to help people who can't afford legal services and create statewide standards on fees, fines and costs. The taskforce says these recommendations aren't meant to put down the current system.

Ed Pappas, judicial crossroads taskforce: "In light of the economic times we're facing, and also in light of the changes that have occurred with technology and everything else, it's more of an improvement on a good system than trying to do away with a bad system."

The taskforce has presented these recommendations to the Michigan Supreme Court. Now it's up to the Supreme Court and legislature to make the changes.
