Notes: Parking is available in the Parking Structure #1 across from the Law School on West Palmer Street for \$4.25/day. **PLEASE NOTE: THE PARKING MACHINES ONLY TAKE CASH, NOT CREDIT CARDS.** The structure is currently undergoing construction and there are some closed off areas, but there should still be enough room for the Diversity Colloquia attendees.

Notes: The closest parking is the Cherry/Commerce ramp is adjacent to the law school. The entrance to the ramp is on Cherry Street just west of Commerce. Rates are \$1.00 per half hour and \$5.50 per day or \$6.00 per day if there is an event.

Notes: Visitor parking is available in the ramp structure next to the Law College Building. **You must park in the METERED SPACES which take ONLY COINS (NO PAPER CASH OR CREDIT CARDS).** The cost is 25¢ per 10 minutes (\$1.50 per hour). Apparently students sometimes simply risk a ticket which is \$10.00. You'll want to consider using the Wharton Center parking structure, which is nearby (see the map link above). The cost is \$5.00/day payable by either cash or credit card.
